

## GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

1. Selection of papers for presentation and discussion will be based on the abstract submitted on [events@kccilhe.edu.in](mailto:events@kccilhe.edu.in) . The abstract of about 300 words must include the purpose, methodology, major findings of the research and the keywords. It should follow the guidelines given below:
2. Length: Max 300 words; Font: Times New Roman; Font Size: 12 points; 1.5 space
3. Title Page: Title, Author(s), Affiliation(s), Contact Details

## GUIDELINES FOR FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

1. Spacing: 15, Font: Times New Roman, Font Size: 12 Points, Margin of one inch all around
2. Title page: The title page of manuscript must include the title of the theme, names of authors including the corresponding author, affiliations, keywords (maximum 5), phone numbers & email.
3. References: APA formatting style. All tables, charts and graphs should be with proper label.
4. Paper must not have been published or accepted for publication elsewhere an undertaking to this effect should appear in the cover letter / email.
5. One Paper may have maximum three Authors only.
